I need to contact the doctor

Doctors at this practice may be contacted during normal surgery hours. Your call will always be transferred through to the doctor or nursing staff in the case of an emergency. Pathology

Pathology is organised by our nursing staff and health workers. Couriers collect from our clinic on a regular basis throughout the day. Pathology services are also located nearby. Staff will direct you to these services if needed.

You will need to make an appointment with your doctor or another doctor at this practice to obtain your results. Due to the *Privacy Act* we are unable to give this information out over the telephone. However, if your results are abnormal we will contact you.

Woolloongabba Clinic is a BULK Billing practice. When you come in for a doctor's appointment, please make sure you bring along your Medicare card, health care card, pension card and/or DVA card with you.

If you don't have a card there will be a minimum fee of \$95.00 for a standard consultation. We request that payment be made at the time of consultation.
