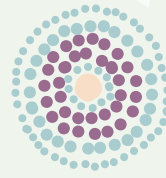

committees, and ethically sound.

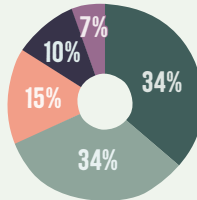
**We have undertaken surveys since 2016

WE SURVEYED **107,970** COMMUNITY MEMBERS BETWEEN 2016–2024

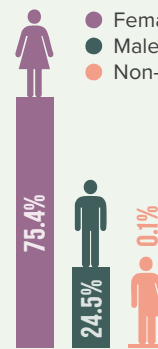
AGE

- Non-binary



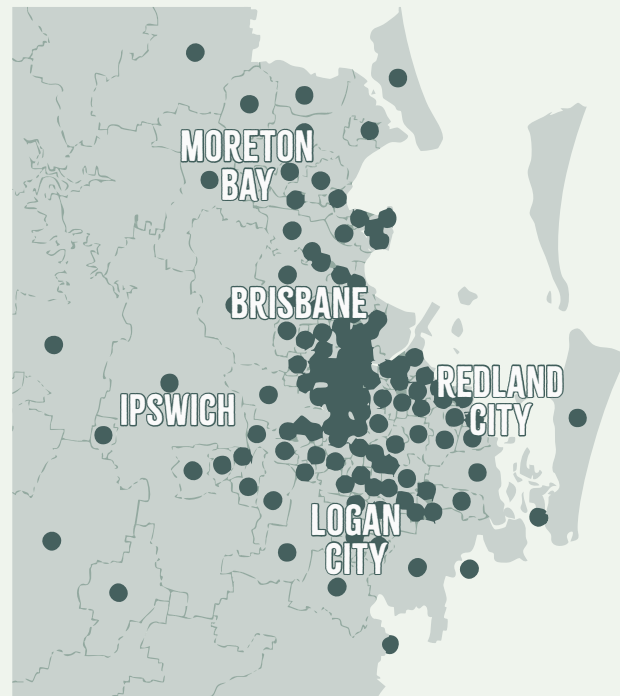
